The Southern HSC Trust provides integrated hospital, community and primary care services to people in the areas of Armagh, Banbridge, Craigavon, Dungannon, South Tyrone, Newry and Mourne:

Craigavon Area Hospital - providing a wide range of acute inpatient and outpatient services serving around 241,000 people including a 24 hour emergency department and dedicated mental health facility

Daisy Hill Hospital - a local teaching hospital hosting a 24 hour emergncy department and an area wide Haemodialysis Unit which has 28 renal stations. The hospital also has an out of hours GP service and a range of mental health services

Lurgan Hospital - a Consultant led assessment clinic for rapid access from GP referrals as well a community stroke rehabilitation service

St Luke's Hospital - providing in-patient care for people with dementia and a one-stop elderly assessment clinic

South Tyrone Hospital - offering a wide range of services including having a 45 bed Rehabilitation Unit and a Rapid Access Clinic for older patients who have been referred by thier GP. The site also has paediatric clinics and provides a full range of mental health and outpatient services
