The Belfast HSC Trust delivers health and social care to the Greater Belfast area through the following hospitals:

**Belfast City Hospital** - a 900 bed modern hospital providing local acute services and important specialties including renal medicine and a comprehensive range of cancer services

**Mater Hospital** - provides acute services in the Northern Belfast area including maternity and A&E services

**Royal Victoria Hospital** - only a few minutes drive from Belfast city centre this hospital provides specialist services such as critical care and hosts the Regional Trauma Centre


**Musgrave Park Hospital** - a non-acute hospital delivering rehabilitation services across Northern Ireland

**Children's Hospital** - the only hospital solely dedicated for the care of children covering a wide range of specialist services

**Royal Maternity** - providing maternity services to the population of Belfast delivering over 5000 babies a year

**Knockbracken** - a healthcare park offering in-patient services for those with mental health issues as well as being home to voluntary organisations working in the healthcare field

**Foster Green Hospital** - delivering non-acute services including neurology and care of older people
